EMPTY APARTMENT SHOPPING LIST

CLEANING SUPPLIES

- 1. Sponges
- 2. Floor cleaner/disinfectant [Mr. Clean/Pinesol]
- 3. Toilet brush/and brush holder
- 4. Washtub for sink/Bucket
- 5. Dish soap (washing by hand) [Joy, Palmolive, etc.]
- 6. Dish drainer with rack
- 7. Dishwasher soap (later)
- 8. Mop (later) or wash cloths

LAUNDRY ITEMS

- 1. Laundry soap [All, Tide, Cheer, Arm & Hammer]
- 2. Laundry basket
- 3. Clothes drying rack

GENERAL HOUSEHOLD

- 1. Wastebaskets (plastic for bathroom and tall plastic for kitchen-under sink) [wicker for bedroom?]
- 2. Hand soap in pump dispenser (refillable)
- 3. Light bulbs [100 watt for reading]

PAPER / PLASTIC PRODUCTS

- 1. Toilet paper
- 2. Tissues
- 3. Napkins
- 4. Plastic food storage container [set is cheaper]
- 5. Small plastic bags for storing food
- 6. Plastic wrap (later)
- 7. Aluminum foil (later)
- 8. Stove burner protectors (aluminum)
- 9. Tall kitchen garbage bags (later)

LINENS

- 1. Sheets
- 2. Blanket
- 3. Pillow [Some comforter sets (reversible sides) come with a sheet & pillow set children's department may be cheaper]
- 4. Towel / washcloth

FURNITURE

- 1. Bed
- 2. Mattress
- 3. Desk
- 4. Desk chair
- 5. Desk lamp
- 6. Bookcase
- 7. Kitchen table and chairs
- 8. Sofa
- 9. Armchair
- 10. Floor lamp(s)

COOKING / BAKING

- 1. Mixing bowl/serving bowl set
- 2. Pots and frying pan [buy a set; cheaper than buying pots separately (may come with spatula and serving spoon)]
- 3. Spatula
- 4. Large serving spoon
- 5. Dishtowel
- 6. Pot holders (set of 2)
- 7. Dishes
- 8. Glasses
- 9. Silverware
- 10. Juice pitcher (later)
- 11. Baking sheet with edges (later)
- 12. Micro-wave cooking dish/plate
- 13. Oven-proof cooking casserole dish (later)
- 14. Trivet (later)
